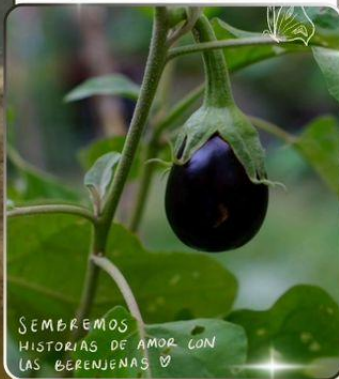

Before modern times, the Tayrona people flourished in the Sierra Nevada de Santa Marta, Colombia. They built stone cities, sacred paths, and agricultural terraces that harmonized with mountains, rivers, and jungle.

Today, as people from different origins, walking in prophecy as Kamunkuabinchi, the new ancient people, walk these lands together, we remember the ancient ways. Guided by the sacred spirit of water, we relearn how to live in balance with Mother Nature once again.

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
